BALTIMORE TOWNSHIP MINUTES – SPECIAL MEETING February 15, 2024

OPEN HEARING; J. Bishop moved to open the meeting, A VanSyckle supported.

UPDATES ON SOLAR STATUS; Atty Kauffman gave an update on the new law that Gov Whitmer signed into affect. Under that law the following options would be available for Solar Projects.

- 1. Follow the MPSC (Michigan Public Service Commission) process benefit to the township is up to \$75K set aside by contractor to intervene in the process as well as a one time payment to the township of \$2K per megawatt.
- 2. Create a Compatible Ordinance (CREO) every affected entity by a project would have to have one that is in agreement with the others.
- 3. Create a Workable Ordinance. This process is still under development. This ordinance could have buffering zones and decommissioning included in them.

Atty Kauffman also discussed the importance of getting constituents to sign the petition to repeal the Governors law on the November ballot. She also discussed the need to work with the county Planning and Zoning to get an ordinance in place to deal with smaller Solar Projects regardless of whether the existing law is repealed.
