

BALTIMORE TOWNSHIP MINUTES – REGULAR MEETING
May 10, 2022

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Supervisor Chad VanSyckle, Treasurer Melissa VanSyckle, Clerk Penelope Ypma, Trustee Aaron VanSyckle, Trustee Jake Ypma.

Meeting called to order at 7 p.m. by Supervisor VanSyckle.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

MINUTES: Without objection or correction, the April 11, 2022 minutes were approved. Moved by J. Ypma, supported by A. VanSyckle. All ayes. Motion carried.

TREASURER’S REPORT: Report provided. No discussion. Approved as read.

CLERK’S REPORT –presented an engagement letter from Walker, Fluke, and Sheldon regarding this year’s audit. Moved by P. Ypma, supported by C. VanSyckle, to hire Walker, Fluke, and Sheldon for the 2021-22 township audit. All aye. Motion carried. ARPA EXPENDITURES:

INTERIOR LIGHTING: Replace lighting system in the hall. Supervisor VanSyckle reported a quote from Morgan Electric in the amount of \$52,468. The board suggested that the supervisor get another quote.

EXTERIOR DOOR REPLACEMENT: Supervisor VanSyckle reported a quote from Cordray Builders to replace the exterior west door on the hall side in the amount of \$2,425. Moved by J. Ypma, supported by C. VanSyckle, to approve Cordray Builders to replace the door. Roll call vote: All Yes. Motion carried.

RESURFACE PARKING LOT: Moved by J. Ypma, supported by C. VanSyckle to hire Murray Asphalt to resurface the parking lot in the amount of \$7,279. Roll call vote: All Yes. Motion carried.

DOWLING CEMETERY EXPANSION: The board discussed purchasing additional land from the property owner to the south of the cemetery. No decision has been made.

NEW BUSINESS:

Supervisor VanSyckle reported receiving a call from a resident who lives in the Hickory Hill Subdivision requesting a petition to resurface the streets in their subdivision.

LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT: Chuck Jordon questioned the supervisor regarding adding an approach to the corner of Mixer Rd. and M-37. Mr. Jordon also requested a slow moving sign be placed in front of his home on Mixer Rd. Supervisor VanSyckle will look into these two request.
